## How to Write a Virtual Notecard

Write what page you found the information on if applicable (not all sources will have page numbers.) Write the note or fact. If it is Source # Page # a direct quote, be sure to put Note/Fact: quotation marks around it. Otherwise, paraphrase or summarize the information. Using your source cards, write which source this is from. **Personal Comment:** This is optional and can be whatever information that may be helpful to you. For example, it may be a personal response or a reminder of where you

want to put this in your paper.
